

# AIRFIELD REGULATIONS

The following is a list of regulations that any air crew, passengers, other people onboard, or any other people involved with them MUST follow whilst on the ground at Malta International Airport (LMML).

## GOOD BEHAVIOUR

- *Crew and representatives must exhibit good behaviour and respect towards the Ground Handling team, security members, support service providers, and Malta International Airport Staff.*

## PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT

- *High Visibility Vest must be worn at all times when transiting on foot in all areas of the airfield.*

## ROAMING / WALKING AROUND

- *Roaming / walking around is not allowed. All persons must remain within the vicinity of the aircraft. No one is allowed to leave the aircraft perimeter without being escorted by a Medavia representative.*

## SMOKING

- *No smoking is allowed in any part of the airfield.*

## AIRCRAFT MOVEMENT

- *Do not remove aircraft chocks / cones, start-up engines or taxi out of stand without the presence of a Medavia marshaller.*

## FUELLING

- *Extreme caution should be taken when re-fuelling aircraft especially in hot weather due to fuel expansion and / or when asking to refuel up to 'full tanks'. Spills cause safety hazard issues. Clean-up fines as imposed by Malta International Airport may be incurred*

Please make sure that crew flying to our station are aware of the above regulations.
